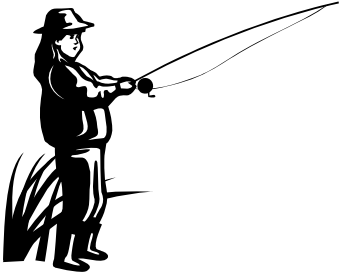
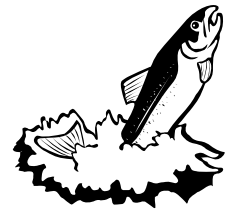

Orders due by May 3rd



Fish Available:

Rainbow Trout or Brook Trout
 6" to 8" (unit size 25 fish per unit)
 10" to 12" (unit size 50 fish per unit)
 (Fish can not be mixed to meet minimum purchase units.)

Prices:

Brook Trout and Rainbow Trout 6" to 8" are \$55 per one unit of 25 fish.
 Brook Trout and Rainbow Trout 10" to 12" are \$180 per one unit of 50 fish.

Floating Trout Feed: 20 lbs. = \$25 40 lbs. = \$35

Pond Design, Installation, and Maintenance booklet = \$5

Pick-up: For fish 6" to 8" (Bagged)

Saturday, May 8th, 1-1:30 PM

Location: **The Concord Center, 10 Ferry St, Concord** (map mailed with invoice)

(Fish must be picked-up within the half-hour scheduled and released into your pond immediately) **Failure to pick-up fish on time results in forfeiture of order!**

Delivery to your pond: For fish 10" to 12"

Saturday May 8th, 2-5 PM Drop Off

Please provide very detailed, written directions to your pond with your order form and payment. Include in directions: your name, town, mileage from turn-offs and intersections, road names, landmarks, and description of property.

The Merrimack County Conservation District is taking orders for New Hampshire raised, disease free rainbow and brook trout. By ordering this spring, your trout can adjust to your pond over the summer and grow to become a tasty feast for you and your family. Some general guidelines for stocking your pond:

- A ¼ acre pond with a depth of 8 ft. that is full all summer with fresh water may support 100 fish
- Brook trout need cold water (approximately 45° to 60° F)
- Rainbow trout tolerate warmer temperatures
- Best pH range is 6 to 9 (brook trout okay at lower end of range, rainbow okay at higher end of range)
- The cleaner the water- the better!
- Use of floating trout feed is recommended for newer ponds
- New ponds should not be stocked until at least 1 year after construction
- Mixing of rainbow and brook trout is not recommended
- Place a screen at the pond's outlet to prevent trout from escaping
