The Stanley Grimes Conservation Scholarship is in memory of Stanley Grimes, Sr. Mr. Grimes who served on the Merrimack County Conservation District Board of Supervisors for 33 years and was also active in his community of Pembroke, NH. Among many other civic roles, Mr. Grimes served on the school board in Pembroke.

A **\$1,000 Scholarship*** will be awarded to a **Merrimack County resident** who has been accepted into a two or four-year program of study in the field of Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental Science, Horticulture, Wetland Science, Environmental Engineering, Soil Science, or other related Natural Resources programs.

**The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to award additional scholarships of varying amounts if funds are available.*

A completed application form must be submitted to the Merrimack County Conservation District Scholarship Committee by **Friday, May 1, 2020**.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Resident of Merrimack County, New Hampshire.
- Accepted at a two or four-year college/university (**full-time** status).
- Enrolled in a program of study in the field of Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental Science, Horticulture, Wetland Science, Environmental Engineering, Soil Science, Wildlife, or a related Natural Resources program.
- Must be attending at accepted college/university in the Fall 2020.

Completed application form must be submitted by **May 1, 2020**

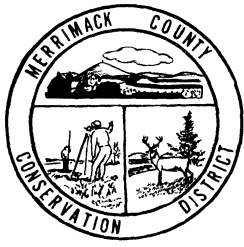
