PLASTIC MULCH LAYER INFORMATION

The plastic mulch layer is a tow behind unit that is adjustable to lay either 3' or 4' wide plastic mulch to create 20" or 30" wide and 4" high raised beds.

The machine simultaneously lays plastic mulch and buries the edges in soil to create a taut covering for the row. A drip attachment is available so that a line of drip tape can be laid underneath the plastic at the same time.

The plastic mulch layer saves time by creating beds, covering them, and laying irrigation all at once. Covering rows with plastic mulch can reduce weed pressure and increase soil moisture retention. Once mulch is laid, holes can be cut in the plastic for precise planting, being careful not to puncture irrigation lines.

- Model RB448 with Drip Attachment
- Adjustable for use with 3' or 4' wide plastic mulch rolls
- Creates raised beds 20" or 30" wide and 4" high
- Bed press smooths the soil to create an even seed bed
- Requires 30-35 Hp tractor for use
