Eligibility Requirements:

- Resident of Merrimack County, New Hampshire.
- Accepted at a two or four-year college/university (full-time status).
- Enrolled in a program of study in the field of Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental Science, Horticulture, Wetland Science, Environmental Engineering, Soil Science, Wildlife, or a related Natural Resources program.
- Must be attending at accepted college/university in the Fall 2022.
