

















Bare Root Plants & Spring Bulbs			
<p><u>Astilbe arendsii ‘Burgundy Red’</u> Bold red feathery flower plumes with dark green foliage. Tolerates some morning sun. <i>Blooms early summer.</i> <i>Height: 20-24” Zone 3-9</i></p>		<p><u>Astilbe Chinensis ‘Peach Blossom’</u> Soft peachy-pink flowers above dense green foliage. Does well in both gardens and containers. <i>Blooms early to mid-summer.</i> <i>Height: 20-24” Zone:3-9</i></p>	
	<p><u>Butterfly Weed (Orange Milkweed)</u> Flat-topped clusters of bright orange flowers. prefers dry, well-drained soils and full sun. NATIVE. <i>Blooms early to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 12-24” Zones: 3-9</i></p>		<p><u>Black Cohosh (Actaea racemosa)</u> Dark green foliage with white, candle-like flower plumes. NATIVE. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-36” Zones 4-8</i></p>
<p><u>Old Fashioned Bleeding Heart (Dicentra spectabilis)</u> Dark green foliage frames arcs of classic red hearts. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-30” Zones: 2-9</i></p>		<p><u>Columbine ‘McKana Hybrids Mix’</u> Star-like bi-color blooms with long spurs on taller stems. NATIVE. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 30-36” Zones: 2-9</i></p>	
	<p><u>Dinner Plate Dahlia ‘Lady Darlene’</u> Fiery flowers consisting of yellow petals with sweeping red accents. Grows up to 8” wide. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 32-36” Zones: 8-10</i></p>		<p><u>Cactus Dahlia ‘Pinelands Princess’</u> Primarily pink, fluffy-looking flowers with a soft white center and strong stems. <i>Blooms Summer to Fall.</i> <i>Height: 32-40” Zones: 8-10</i></p>
<p><u>Semi Cactus Dahlia ‘Purple Gem’</u> Jewel-toned blooms vary from magenta pink to deep purple. Grows up to 6” wide. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 36-40” Zones 8-10</i></p>		<p><u>Daylily/Hemerocallis ‘Lies & Lipstick’</u> Large blooms up to 5.5”. Ruffled soft pink petals with red center and petal edges. <i>Blooms mid to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-30” Zones:3-9</i></p>	
	<p><u>Echinacea Mix ‘Pink and White’</u> A colorful mix of pink and white tall, sturdy daisy-like flowers. NATIVE. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 24-36” Zones: 4-9</i></p>		<p><u>Foxtail Lily</u> Tall tapered spikes of sunshine yellow flowers that bloom from the bottom up. Needs moist soil. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 72-96” Zones: 5-9</i></p>
<p><u>Geranium sanguineum Var. Striatum</u> Sweet pale pink flowers with lavender veins atop compact green leaves. Lobed leaves turn bronzy-red in fall. Dwarf geranium variety. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 6-8” Zones: 3-9</i></p>		<p><u>Goat’s Beard (Aruncus diocius ‘Kneiffii’)</u> White wispy plumes attractive to pollinators. Golden-yellow daisy like flowers with a light brown center. NATIVE. <i>Blooms summer to fall</i> <i>Height: 30-36” Zones: 2-9</i></p>	
	<p><u>Hosta ‘Captain Kirk’</u> Broad yellow-green leaves with dark green margins and pale lavender flowers. <i>Blooms mid summer</i> <i>Height: 20-24” Zones: 2-9</i></p>		<p><u>Iris ‘Butter & Sugar’</u> Buttery-yellow lower petals frame soft white inner petals. <i>Blooms early summer.</i> <i>Height: 26-28” Zones: 3-9</i></p>
<p><u>Iris ensata ‘Nessa No Mai’</u> 9” blooms of royal purple with speckled white centers and slight yellow accents. petals. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 28-30” Zones: 4-9</i></p>		<p><u>Asiatic Lily ‘Landini’</u> Deep dark burgundy, nearly black lily flowers with sturdy stems. Blooms in 90 days. <i>Booms summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-40” Zones:2-9</i></p>

Long lasting blooms. <i>Booms summer.</i> <i>Height: 32-40” Zones:3-8</i></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Garden Peony ‘Alertie’</u></p> <p>Double blooming light pink peony. Very high productivity. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 20-24” Zones: 3-9</i></p> 
 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Garden Phlox ‘Goliath’</u></p> <p>Large plumes of purple flowers with a white center. Largest and most disease resistant phlox available. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height: 26-30” Zones: 4-8</i></p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Solomon’s Seal (<i>Polygonatum multiflorum</i>)</u></p> <p>Creamy white bells on arching stems with light green leaves. Berries in fall. Berries are toxic. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height: 18-24” Zones: 3-9</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Stonecrop (<i>Sedum ‘Matrona’</i>)</u></p> <p>Densely packed clumps of pale pink flowers atop burgundy stems with purple tinged leaves. Drought tolerant. <i>Blooms mid-summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 18-24” Zones: 3-9</i></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gladiolus ‘Natan’</u></p> <p>Bold fuchsia blooms with a velvety texture. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 48-60” Zones: 8-11</i></p> 
 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gladiolus ‘Pastel Blend’</u></p> <p>A pastel blend of various shades of pink, purple, orange, yellow, and white. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 48-60” Zones: 8-11</i></p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Gladiolus ‘Prima Verde’</u></p> <p>Large green-yellow flowers with a signature slim red stripe on the lower center petal. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 48-60” Zones: 8-11</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Liatris Spicata ‘Floristan Violet’</u></p> <p>Fluffy wands of Magenta-purple flowers. very attractive to pollinators. <i>Blooms mid-summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 36-48” Zones: 3-9</i></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Lily of the Valley ‘Convallaria’</u></p> <p>Fragrant creamy white bells with standard wide leaves. Great as ground cover in moist shady spots. Toxic. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height 4-6” Zones: 2-8</i></p>

 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Yarrow Gold (<i>Achillea</i>)</u></p> <p>Flat golden flower heads stand atop tall silvery-green stems. Easy to grow. <i>Blooms early spring.</i> <i>Height: 24-36” Zones: 3-8</i></p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Violet Bellflower (<i>Campanula persicifolia</i>)</u></p> <p>Whimsical blue-violet bell-shaped flowers. Frequent cutting will promote re-blooming. <i>Blooms June-July.</i> <i>Height:30-48” Zone:2-6</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Joe Pye Weed</u></p> <p>Very tall perennial with clumps of pinkish-purple flowers on sturdy stems. Quite attractive to pollinators. NATIVE. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height: 60-84” Zone: 4-9</i></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Shasta Daisy (<i>Leucanthemum</i>)</u></p> <p>Large white flowers with a yellow center. Makes for great cut flowers. Blooms summer through fall. <i>Height: 10-12” Zone: 5-9</i></p> 
 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bee Balm (<i>Monarda</i>)</u></p> <p>Lovely purple tubular flowers with pink accents. Mildew-resistant. Excellent for pollinators. NATIVE. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height 36-40” Zone: 4-9</i></p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sneezeweed (<i>Helenium</i>)</u></p> <p>Warm, rusty-yellow round blooms grow in tall clumps. Not allergy-inducing! NATIVE. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-60” Zones: 3-8</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Low Bush Blueberry</u></p> <p>Small shrub with small elongated bell-shaped flowers that turn into common blueberries. Long lived.
