Compact astilbe that does well in both gardens and containers. Part-shade. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-28" Zone: 3-8</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Butterfly Weed (Orange Milkweed)</u></p> <p>Flat-topped clusters of bright orange flowers. prefers dry, well-drained soils and full sun. <i>Blooms early to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 12-24" Zones: 3-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Black Cohosh (Actaea racemosa)</u></p> <p>Dark green foliage with white, candle-like flower plumes. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-36" Zones 4-8</i></p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Ball Dahlia 'Wizard of Oz'</u></p> <p>Round and whimsical pink flowers with strong stems. 3" flowers. Good for gardens and containers. <i>Blooms Summer to Fall.</i> <i>Height: 38-42" Zones: 8-10</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Decorative Dahlia 'Saint Martin'</u></p> <p>White flowers with rosy petal tips. Graceful blooms up to 8" in diameter. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 30-36" Zones 8-10</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Dinner Plate Dahlia 'Advance'</u></p> <p>Ivory-yellow petals with a center splashed in pastel pink. Can grow up to 10" wide. <i>Blooms mid-summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 40-45" Zones: 8-10</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Daylily/Hemerocallis 'Heavenly Pink Fang'</u></p> <p>Elegant pink petals with golden ruffled edges. Abundant bloom producer established plant. Rebloomer. <i>Blooms mid to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 20-22" Zones:3-9</i></p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geranium 'Johnson's Blue'</u></p> <p>Classic geranium of violet-blue flowers and deeply lobed foliage. <i>Blooms late spring to midsummer.</i> <i>Height: 20-24" Zones: 2-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Globe Thistle (Echinops ritro)</u></p> <p>Repeat bloomer of round, blue puffs atop sturdy stems. Drought-tolerant once established. Great border plant. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 36-40" Zones: 2-9</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Goat's Beard (Aruncus dioicius 'Kneiffii')</u></p> <p>White, wispy plumes very attractive to pollinators. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 30-36" Zones: 2-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Hosta 'Minuteman'</u></p> <p>Compact mound of dark green leaves with lovely white edges. Pale lavender flowers. <i>Blooms mid-summer.</i> <i>Height: 20-24" Zones: 2-9</i></p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Iris Siberian 'Paprikash'</u></p> <p>Striking blooms of violet-peach standards surrounded by copper-red falls. <i>Blooms early summer.</i> <i>Height: 18-24" Zones: 3-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Oriental Lily 'The Edge'</u></p> <p>Fragrant, stunning white flowers with a delicate pink edge on every petal. Blooms in 95 days. <i>Booms summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-40" Zones: 3-9</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Lungwort 'Mrs Moon'</u></p> <p>Deep green foliage speckled in silver. Pink blooms in early spring mature into blue. Prefers some shade. <i>Blooms early to mid-spring.</i> <i>Height: 10-12" Zones: 2-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Garden Peony 'Miss America'</u></p> <p>Adorable double white peonies with a happy yellow center. Fragrant. Tolerates heat and humidity. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-40" Zones: 3-9</i></p>

Largest and most disease resistant phlox available. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height: 26-30" Zones: 4-8</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Shooting Star 'Aphrodite' (Dodecatheon media)</u></p> <p>Lilac-pink blooms atop slender stalks with a low, compact foliage below. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 10-12" Zones: 3-9</i></p>

Great as ground cover in moist shady spots. <i>Blooms spring.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Height 4-6" Zones: 2-8</i></p>

Easy to grow. <i>Blooms early spring.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Height: 24-36" Zones: 3-8</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Coneflower (Pink)</u></p> <p>Deep pink rays with large cones. Sun/ part-shade. Highly fragrant. <i>Blooms summer.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Height: 18-30" Zone: 4-9</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Marginal Wood Fern</u></p> <p>Thick, leathery leaves that stay green over winter. Part-shade, acidic well-drained soils. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bee Balm (Monarda)</u></p> <p>Lovely red tubular flowers with pink accents. Mildew-resistant. Excellent for pollinators. <i>Blooms late summer.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Height 36-40" Zone: 4-9</i></p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Black-Eyed Susan</u></p> <p>Compact rudbeckia with up to 80 blooms on one plant. Low maintenance. Can be a container plant. Pollinator plant. Sun/ Part-shade. <i>Blooms late summer.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Height: 8-18" Zones: 4-10</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bleeding Heart</u></p> <p>Rosy-pink heart-shaped leaves. Blue-green foliage. Deer resistance.
