




















Bare Root Plants & Spring Bulbs			
<b><u>Astilbe Younique ‘Silvery Pink’</u></b> Soft Pink flower plumes with dark green fern like foliage. Shade plant. <i>Blooms early to mid-summer.</i> <i>Height: 16-20” Zone 3-9</i>		<b><u>Astilbe Chinensis ‘Pumila’</u></b> Lavender-purple flower plumes above green, fern-like foliage. Shade plant. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height: 10-12” Zone:3-8</i>	
			
 <b><u>Butterfly Weed (Orange Milkweed)</u></b> Flat-topped clusters of bright orange flowers. prefers dry, well-drained soils and full sun. Important for Monarch Butterflies & other pollinators. <i>Blooms early to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 12-24” Zones: 3-9</i>		 <b><u>Black Cohosh (Actaea racemosa)</u></b> Dark green foliage with white, candle-like flower plumes. Native. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-36” Zones 4-8</i>	
<b><u>Bloodroot (Sanguinaria canadensis)</u></b> Charming blooms of 8-10 white petals with buttery-yellow centers that grow above a distinctive lobed leaf. Native. <i>Blooms early spring.</i> <i>Height: 6-10” Zones: 3-8</i>		 <b><u>Dinner Plate Dahlia ‘Mom’s Special’</u></b> White double bloom with vibrant lilac purple striping. Grows up to 8” wide. Dig up in fall and replant in spring. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 44-48” Zones: 8-10</i>	
 <b><u>Dark Angel Dahlia ‘Star Wars’</u></b> Compact, bright orange petals that turn lighter in the middle with dark centers. Offset by dark foliage. Dig up in fall and replant in spring. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 10-12” Zones 8-10</i>		 <b><u>Daylily/Hemerocallis ‘Regency Heights’</u></b> Large blooms up to 6”. Ruffle lavender petals with vivid yellow centers. <i>Blooms mid to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-30” Zones:3-9</i>	
<b><u>Dutchman's Breeches (Dicentra cucullaria)</u></b> Feathered fern like leaves with tall stalks of pantaloone-shaped flowers. Native. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height: 8-10” Zones: 3-8</i>		 <b><u>Echinacea Mix</u></b> A colorful mix of tall, sturdy daisy-like flowers. colors range from white, yellow, & pink. <i>Blooms summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 24-36” Zones:4-9</i>	
 <b><u>False Sunflower ‘Summer Sun’</u></b> Golden-yellow daisy like flowers with a light brown center. <i>Blooms summer to fall</i> <i>Height: 35-47” Zones: 2-9</i>		 <b><u>Hosta ‘Patriot’</u></b> Deep green leaves with wider cream-colored margins. Lavender flowers. <i>Blooms mid summer</i> <i>Height: 21-23” Zones: 2-9</i>	
<b><u>Iris Germanica ‘Frappe’ (rebloomer)</u></b> Colors vary from pale strawberry pink to pinkish white. Lower petals darker than upper petals. <i>Blooms late spring to mid summer.</i> <i>Height: 32-36” Zones: 3-9</i>		 <b><u>Joe-Pye Weed ‘Baby Joe’</u></b> Dwarf plant of course green leaves bearing large clumps of purple flowers. great for pollinators. <i>Blooms mid-summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 27-29” Zones: 4-9</i>	
		<b><u>Oriental Lily ‘Solution’</u></b> Large white flowers with raspberry speckles and pink streaks on center of each petal. <i>Booms summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-48” Zones:3-9</i>	
		 <b><u>Tiger Lily ‘Pink Giant’</u></b> Light pink, gracefully recurved flowers that are tipped with black spots. Perfect for borders and a favorite for perennializing. <i>Booms summer.</i> <i>Height: 36-48” Zones:3-8</i>	
<b><u>Garden Peony ‘Red Magic’</u></b> Huge blooms of feathered, deep red petals. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 28-36” Zones: 3-8</i>		 <b><u>Garden Phlox ‘Orange Delite’</u></b> Dense clumps of salmon-orange flowers with a deep red center. <i>Blooms mid to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 14-16” Zones: 4-8</i>

	<p><b><u>Shooting Star 'Aphrodite' (Dodecatheon media)</u></b> Lilac-pink blooms atop slender stalks with a low, compact foliage below. <i>Blooms late spring to early summer.</i> <i>Height: 10-12" Zones: 3-9</i></p>		<p><b><u>Trillium 'Snowy White'</u></b> Native woodland wildflower with green leaves and snowy white ruffled petals. Native. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height: 12-14" Zones: 4-8</i></p>
<p><b><u>Gladiolus 'Moon Mixture'</u></b> A lovely mix of cool toned blooms in blue, purple, and lilac shades. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 56-60" Zones: 8-11</i></p>		<p><b><u>Gladiolus 'Priscilla'</u></b> Heavily ruffled white flowers with dark pink edges that fades to light pink going inwards, and a soft yellow center. Dig up in fall and replant in spring. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 50-60" Zones: 8-11</i></p>	
	<p><b><u>Gladiolus 'Yellowstone'</u></b> Sunshine-yellow blooms. A classic gladiolus with tall dark greens. Dig up in fall and replant in spring. <i>Blooms summer.</i> <i>Height: 56-60" Zones: 8-11</i></p>		<p><b><u>Liatris Spicata 'Floristan Violet'</u></b> Fluffy wands of Magenta-purple flowers. very attractive to pollinators. <i>Blooms mid-summer to fall.</i> <i>Height: 36-48" Zones: 3-9</i></p>
<p><b><u>Lily of the Valley 'Convallaria'</u></b> Fragrant creamy white bells with standard wide leaves. Great as ground cover in moist shady spots. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height 4-6" Zones: 2-8</i></p>		<p><b>All selections promote pollinators or other native wildlife. Consider planting multiple species that bloom at different parts of the year to maximize pollinator benefits.</b></p>	

### Locally Grown Premium Potted Plants

	<p><b><u>Bearberry (Arctostaphylos uva ursi)</u></b> Long stemmed ground cover with shiny leaves and small light pink blooms turn to red berries. Host plant for several butterflies. Native. <i>Blooms early summer.</i> <i>Height: 6-12" Zone: 2-6</i></p>		<p><b><u>Bee Balm (Monarda)</u></b> Lovely red tubular flowers with pink accents. Mildew-resistant. Excellent for pollinators. <i>Blooms late summer.</i> <i>Height 36-40" Zone: 4-9</i></p>
<p><b><u>Canadian Columbine (Aquilegia canadense)</u></b> Drooping, bell-like flowers with red outer petals and yellow center petals. Quite attractive to hummingbirds. Native. <i>Blooms early spring. Height: 24-36" Zones: 3-8</i></p>		<p><b><u>Low Bush Blueberry (Vaccinium angustifolium)</u></b> Small shrub with small elongated bell-shaped flowers that turn into common blueberries. Native. <i>Blooms spring.</i> <i>Height: 12-36" Zones: 2-8</i></p>	
	<p><b><u>Shasta Daisy (Leucanthemum)</u></b> Large white flowers with a yellow center. Makes for great cut flowers. <i>Blooms summer through fall</i> <i>Height: 10-12" Zone: 5-9</i></p>		<p><b><u>Mountain Mint (Pycnanthemum virginianum)</u></b> Numerous small, dense clusters of tiny white flowers often spotted with purple. Native. <i>Blooms mid to late summer.</i> <i>Height: 24-36" Zones: 3-7</i></p>
<p><b><u>Wild Ginger (Asarum canadense)</u></b> Low, colony-forming plant. Each plant bears a pair of heart shaped leaves and a single dark maroon flower. Hosts swallowtail butterflies.
